#### **Pool Vehicle Gate**

The BOD approved installation of a **vehicle gate at the entry to the Center Pointe pool** by Eagle Gateworks. This will give the Association the ability to control access to the parking lot which is used by non-residents to access our amenities, and help protect them for Center Pointe owners who bear the cost of maintaining these facilities.

The cost of the gate is \$21,000, the design is a scaled down version of The Cove gates, and will operate on a timer to remain open during the day, closed at night. Alternative access features such as a FOB or RFID Reader can be added in the future for 4-5K.

Data from residents reports, neighborhood watch, last summer's security guard, and consultations with OVPD, indicate the trend is non-residents arriving by car in the pool parking lot to gain access to the pool and grounds.

#### Crushed Rock

The Board approved the **DG** (Crushed Rock) Committee recommendation for a replenishment plan at Center Pointe. A reserve expenditure, the project will be broken into three phases (south, central, north) starting this Fall. The rock will be delivered from Kalamazoo quarry and spread by Brightview.
