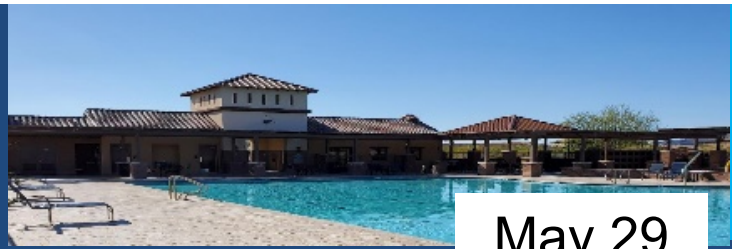

## Wall Painting Update

The Cove is nearing completion.

**Desert Crest I painting will begin the week of June 1.**

*All work is weather dependent with timing and schedule notifications given in advance as much as possible. Expect the contractor to be on site at Centre Pointe throughout this year.*

The Association is painting the exterior side of the masonry block and stucco walls that sit on the boundary lines between owner lots and the common areas. Owners who would like to address their interior masonry walls may independently contract with Approved Painting. For a quote call 520-825-9596 or 520-349-3276.

The painters are working on the metal view fences primarily from the exterior side and owners are asked to help by tying back or covering vegetation and attachments such as vines, trees, snake fences, lights, wall art, wiring, and bird feeders that touch the metal view fence. Snake fences will be painted unless they are removed.

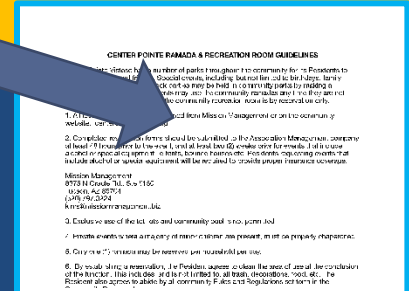
The Recreation Room/Clubhouse is now available for private use reservations. Reservation forms and details on deposits and cleaning instructions are on the CPV website
